Ingram Road Pinot Noir 2014

At Helen's Hill Estate, Pinot Noir is by far our biggest grown variety. We have been growing it for many years, supplying well known Pinot Noir labels such as Coldstream Hills and producing our own Helen's Hill label.

Following traditional winemaking processes, utilizing full French oak maturation our Ingram Pinot Noir display rich varietal characters on the nose, sweet cherry and strawberry flavours on the front and mid palate with a savoury, earthy (spicy) finish on the back palate. Thanks to the French oak, the wine has a wonderful full textural mouth weight and long lasting finish. The best Pinot Noir under \$20.00? We would like to think so!
