

Swift hails from the elevated slopes of Orange, NSW and is owned and managed by the Swift family.

The cool climate and elevated vineyard sites are perfect for the production of traditional method sparkling wines. Swift is the extension of these sites. Hand picked fruit, gently handled and blended to create a range of premium sparkling wines now regarded as some of the best in the state.

Extended lees aging is a feature of the wines, rewarding with complexity yet retaining freshness and vibrancy.



2011 GRARDONNAY VINTAGE FINOT NOIR BIRUT

2010 Blanc de Blancs

The flagship wine. 100% Chardonnay picked from a single, east facing vineyard site at an elevation of 1,000m. The wine holds it's line and length with grace while the extended lees age offers a touch of developed honey and brioche. Still youthful and will continue to reward with some further lees age.

2011 Vintage Chardonnay Pinot Noir

This is the reserve Chardonnay, Pinot Noir blend. 65% Chardonnay, 35% Pinot Noir. A wonderfully complex wine that while having 5 years of lees age still looks refreshingly youthful and bright. Acid creates tension on the palate with a touch of savoriness starting to develop.

Tirage Date: August 2011 Disgorge Date: September 2016 Dosage: 4.5g/L

2011 Rosé

Perfect for the summer drinking weather with a beautiful pink blush. A dry, savory wine blended from Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. A fine line of acid forms the backbone with the mid-palate showing lovely pinot strawberry richness. Texture is created by 5 years of lees aging.

Tirage Date: August 2011 Disgorge Date: September 2016 Dosage: 5g/L

NV Swift Cuvée

This is the entry to the Swift portfolio. A non-vintage wine blended using 70% Chardonnay and 30% Pinot Noir. A 30% non-vintage reserve portion is utilised to offer consistency to each Cuvée. The Chardonnay fruit dominates the palate with a nice strawberry richness to finish. 5 years of bottle lees aging.
